

Short report from the meeting at the Czech and Slovak Number Theory Conference

On Monday, August 28 there was a short informal meeting of a group of traditional participants of the conference series. The main topic of the meeting was the discussion about the possibility to transform the current formal status of the conference series from the Czech and Slovak to the Central European Number Theory Conference (CENTCO).

The proposal of the transformation was presented by L. Mišík. It was supported successively by K. Győry, K. Nemoga and other participants. There was a discussion about the timing and location of the future conferences. Participants mainly discussed the possible conflicts with other series of traditional series of conferences in related topics. At the end, taking into account the long history of the conference series they suggest the following model:

Conferences will be held in the beginning of September of the odd years switching Czech or Slovak venue with venues in other countries (Hungary, Austria, Croatia, ...). The next conference will be held in September 2019 in Slovakia.
